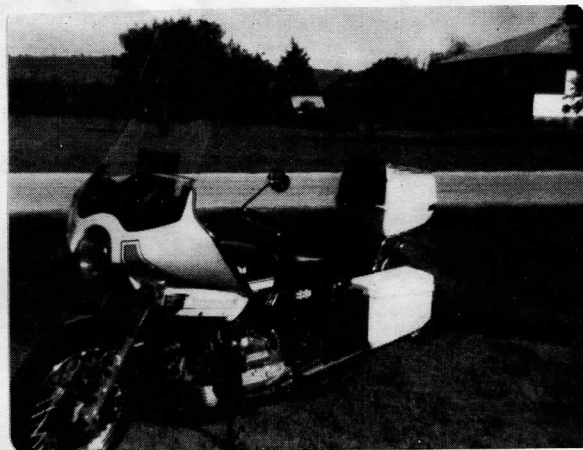
CUSTOM DOUBLE SADDLE TOURING SEATS AVAILBLE
