as exciting as the actual races. Sunday morning is more practice and right after lunch is the start of Sprint races. (The exception to this schedule is our August race which includes the five hour endurance team race in addition to the Sprint races).

We have 14 classes of racing motorcycles from three main categories. These are Production (stock), cafe (modified street legal) and Grand Prix (unlimited modifications). Large displacement GP bikes will reach 180 miles per hour on the main straightaway.

Admission for spectators is \$5.00 for the entire weekend. This includes access to the paddock area where the racers and competition bikes are normally found. Camping is available at the track for \$2.50 per night or \$4.00 for the weekend. (This camping fee is collected for the Track and does not go to CRA)

Last year our 5-hour endurance race was won by a Louisiana 860 Duke; we also managed to attract quite a few other Midwest Ducatis in various degrees of tune, both singles and twins. May I direct your attention to our July AMA regional race this year - an indication of our growing club and increased interest.

The Brainer International Raceway is 3.1 miles long with lap times around two minutes for quicker bikes.

Dont forget that this is club level racing that more and more of us snowbirds are coming to enjoy as being far safer and thus more fun!

DUCATI FOR MODEL BUILDERS

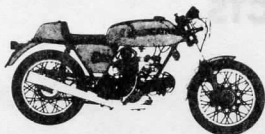

Plastic is good match of yellow for f/g parts. It does take patience as it is very detailed and some parts should be painted to make exact duplicate, but it's less dirty than adjusting Desmo valves!

Well worth the time especially for those of us who have wrecks or sold their Sport by accident- (brings back fond memories - I won't mention any names.) (Grrrrrrrrrrrr. ed.)

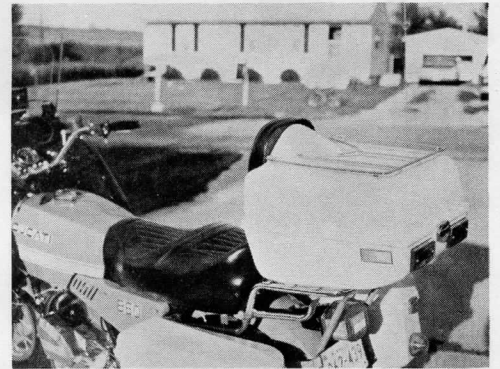
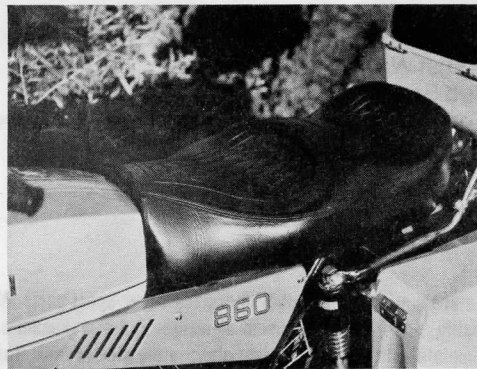
