Phil Beck on a Moto Guzzi took fifth overall, second Expert Modified. Right behind came Amateur Modified winner Doug Gross on a Ducati. Vance Breese took his S&S Prod./Bub Ent. Harley to seventh, fourth GP bike, followed by Palo Alto to Yamaha's Lou Vallerga aboard a four-stroke for the first time, a Yamaha vertical twin utilizing a Harry Lillie 750 motor. "I like it; I think I'll go do another one" he said of both the machine's and his debut.

Chris Steward took the Stock class win easily on his Yamaha Mtr. Corp./ APA Trk./Kal-Gard XV920. •

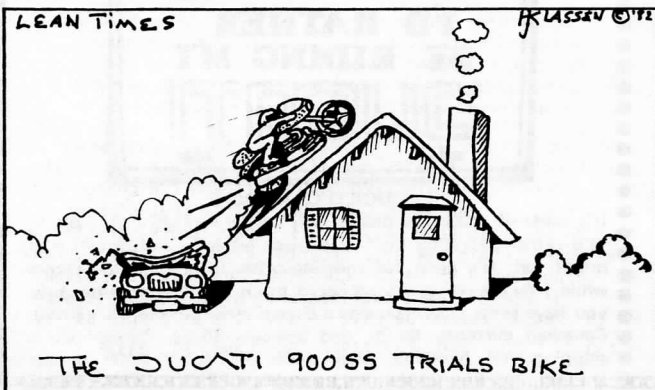

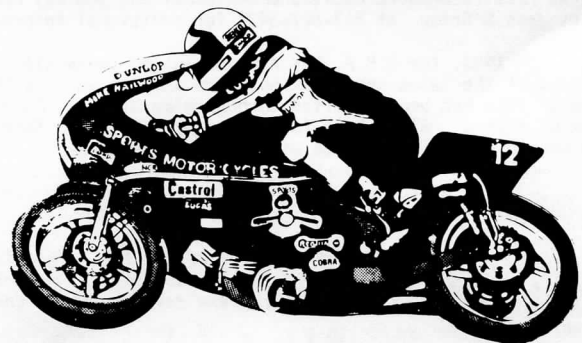
